I send Easter Blessings your way at this most glorious time of the year. Easter is a day to celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ.

It is also the time to remember the sacrifice that Jesus made for everyone. It is a day when we can all come together and our bonds can become even stronger. A time for you to share the message of God with everyone and bring happiness, peace, and love into their lives.

PALM SUNDAY & HOLY WEEK

Palm Sunday marks the beginning of the most sacred week of the liturgical year. We reflect on the triumphant entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem, not only to celebrate the Passover, but to accomplish His Paschal Mystery. He rode on a donkey, a sign of peace, and was greeted by a large number crying out "Hosanna! Blessed is He who comes in the name of the Lord" Within a week they will be shouting "Crucify Him"

Our procession today is meant to be an image of something deeper, to focus on the fact that together with Jesus we too are setting out on a pilgrimage along the high road that leads to the living God. As is our tradition we will gather in the hall with our palms, process around the outside of the building and back in to church to start the Mass with a blessing of the palms Holy Week is a time of immediate preparation for the Triduum and the sacred three days of Maundy Thursday (The Mass of the Lord's Supper), Good Friday (Our Lord's crucifixion and death) and the great celebration of the

Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday. The Triduum forms one continuous liturgy and therefore we are encouraged to attend all the services.
