NEW BISHOP CHRISTOPHER RIP

Bishop Christopher passed away in the early hours of Saturday 1st April, at his home in Lyme Regis, Dorset. He held the title of Emeritus Bishop Of Plymouth, following his retirement in 2013 after 27 years as our Bishop. Canon Mark O'Keefe, said: "It is with great sadness that we have heard the news that our Emeritus Bishop Christopher has died.'

"Bishop Budd was ordained to the priesthood in July 1962 and ordained bishop in Plymouth Cathedral on January 15, 1986. He was a member of the Bishops' Conference Department for Social Justice." Canon Paul Cummins, Plymouth Diocesan administrator, said: "Bishop Christopher was a faithful servant of the Lord and of the Church'.

We shall miss him greatly. Funeral details will follow when we have more information.
