YOUTH MINISTRY RESIDENTIAL

In the autumn I will be running a social justice residential at St Rita's Honiton, this will run 20th – 22nd October and will be jointly run with the Columban's. The residential is aimed at those who are Year 8 – Year 12 but under 18. At this stage I wanted to make parishes aware of the residential, particularly because it is a brilliant opportunity for those who have either prepared or are preparing for their confirmation. Full details and costs will be available nearer the time. If you feel you would like to bring a group or reserve places, please email me. If you are planning to bring a group you are welcome to send a volunteer with them or simply encourage individuals to sign up. Bookings for individuals will be open July/ August time. During the weekend young people will have a chance to explore what it means to live as a refugee or asylum seeker and to consider what Jesus means when he talks about 'Loving your neighbour as yourself', at the end of the weekend individuals and/ or parish groups will have a plan of action. Workshops and activities will be discursive, offering young people to explore the subject area, to develop their understanding and challenge thoughts.
