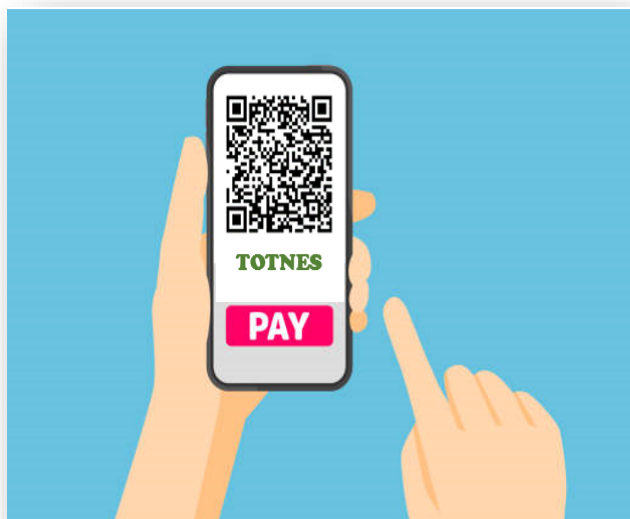
COUNSELLING HELPLINE IN PLYMOUTH DIOCESE
