



POPE'S MESSAGE REGARDING CLIMATE CHANGE

On The Feast of St Francis of Assisi, Pope Francis published *Laudate Deum: to all people of good will on the climate crisis*, his new Exhortation on the environment, a follow up to his encyclical, *Laudato Si'*. The Pope says that "climate change is one of the principal challenges facing society and the global community" (*Laudate Deum* #3) and warns that the "world in which we live is collapsing and may be nearing the breaking point" (#5).
