

*** NEW*** INSTALLATION OF OUR NEW BISHOP, CHRISTOPHER WHITEHEAD

With great joy and gratitude, we are looking forward to the upcoming Episcopal Ordination and Installation of our new Bishop, Christopher Whitehead in the Cathedral on 22 February. We hope that as many people as possible will engage with this wonderful opportunity to celebrate a new chapter in the history of the Diocese of Plymouth. There will be a number of opportunities for people to join in this historic occasion:

21 February at 5.30 pm – There will be a Service of Solemn Vespers at Plymouth Cathedral open to all the evening before the Ordination and Installation Mass for those wishing to come and pray with and for the Bishop-elect as he prepares for the following day's profoundly significant ceremonies for him and for our diocese.

22 February at 12.00 noon - We deeply regret that as the seating capacity of our Cathedral is extremely limited, attendance at the Ordination Mass is by invitation only. The guest list includes representatives from all our parishes, Bishops of England and Wales, ecumenical and interfaith guests, civic leaders, representatives of those being supported by our diocesan safeguarding team, clergy who have journeyed alongside the Bishop-elect and, of course, his close family and friends. Our own diocesan priests and deacons, seminarians and representatives of religious communities will be taking part.

Please note that there will be no parking at the Cathedral for these events.

Online - both the Solemn Vespers and the Ordination Mass and Installation will be live-streamed. All events will be shared on <u>Plymouth Diocese - YouTube</u>

In a recent interview Canon Christopher said "I am excited and touched that Pope Francis has entrusted this new Ministry in my life to me; this challenging and wonderful opportunity to serve the Catholic Community in Cornwall, Devon and Dorset". We look forward as a diocese to welcoming our new Bishop fully over the exciting year ahead and let us continue to keep him in our prayers.

Modern slavery is a serious crime being committed across the UK in which victims are exploited for someone else's gain. It can take many forms including trafficking of people, forced labour and servitude. Victims are often hidden away, may be unable to leave their situation, or may not come forward because of fear or shame. This 2-hour event will hear from a range of speakers about modern slavery in our Diocese and how we are called to respond. There will be practical advice about what to look out for and what we can do if we have concerns. The event will take place on the Feast of St Bakhita, patron of victims of modern slavery, on Thursday 8th February from 10.30-12.30 at the Church of the Assumption of Our Lady parish rooms in Abbey Road, Torquay TQ2 5NJ and will be followed by a free light lunch.
