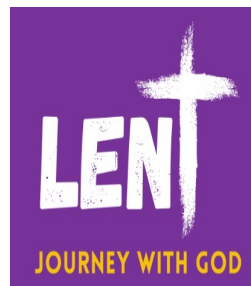

TOTNES CHURCH CAR PARK

It has been noticed that our car park is increasingly being used for unauthorised parking. This is expected to become a greater problem when the Churchill development is fully occupied. Accordingly, the current parking permits are going to be replaced with new ones that will show the car registration and will be valid for the next two years. Application forms for the new permits are at the back of the church or can be obtained by contacting Caroline, our parish secretary. The permits will only be issued to bona fide registered parishioners who make a financial contribution to the parish (e.g., Planned Giving, Gift Aid etc). To cover administration expenses the permits will cost £10 for each permit issued. The car park should only be used by parishioners attending church services or for short parking while shopping etc in town. Overnight parking is not permitted.

NB The car park barrier may be locked at night.

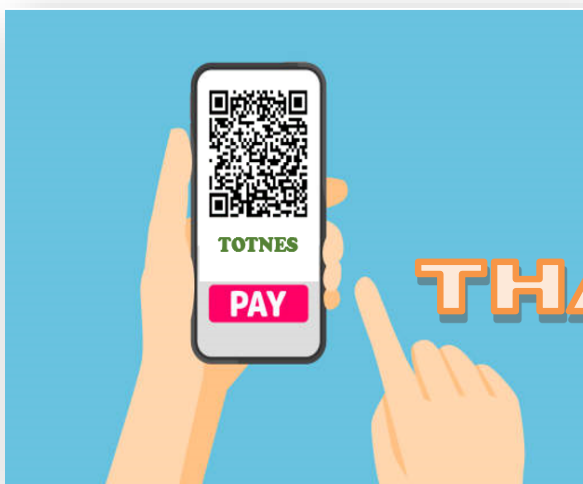

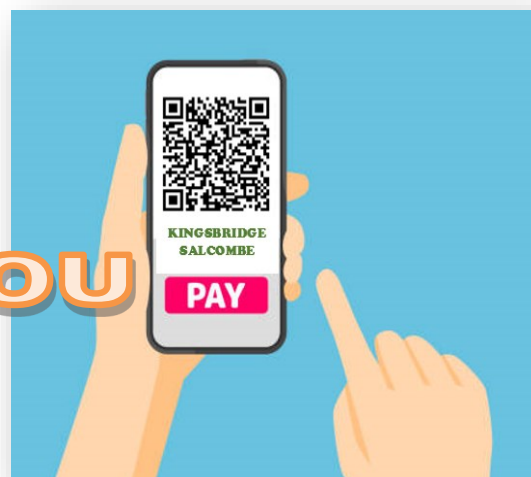

NEW TEACHER RECRUITMENT: NATURAL FAMILY PLANNING (NFP) SOUTH WEST – IN SUPPORT OF MARRIAGE AND FAMILY LIFE

We are looking to recruit and train new teachers to become part of a team delivering the Billings Ovulation Method (BOM) in the Plymouth Diocese. Applicants will need to chart their own fertility to gain experience. Training will be via correspondence modules. All learning must be completed within a 2 year time frame. Training is organised by Billings Method England (BME) which is the national accrediting body. Once accredited, you will be expected to attend 2 local diocesan study days per year in person and attend 2 BME Zoom training sessions per year.
