CAR SHARE FOR HOLY TRIDUUM

For those Parishioners from Totnes who are attending Masses at Kingsbridge and are able to offer lifts to fellow parishioners from Totnes who do not have transport please could you add your name to the list at the back of the church.

TOTNES CHURCH CAR PARK

It has been noticed that our car park is increasingly being used for unauthorised parking. This is expected to become a greater problem when the Churchill development is fully occupied. Accordingly, the current parking permits are going to be replaced with new ones that will show the car registration and will be valid for the next two years. Application forms for the new permits are at the back of the church or can be obtained by contacting Caroline, our parish secretary. The permits will only be issued to bona fide registered parishioners who make a financial contribution to the parish (e.g., Planned Giving, Gift Aid etc). To cover administration expenses the permits will cost £10 for each permit issued. The car park should only be used by parishioners attending church services or for **short** parking while shopping etc in town. Overnight parking is not permitted. **NB** The car park barrier may be locked at night.
