TOTNES CHURCH CAR PARK

The car park should only be used by parishioners attending church services or for **short** parking while shopping etc in town. Overnight parking is not permitted.

NEW DAY OF PRAYER FOR VICTIMS AND SURVIVORS OF ABUSE – 30TH APRIL 2024

The Bishop's of England and Wales have set aside the Tuesday of the Fifth Week of Easter as a Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse. This is a day of prayer for those who have been abused, during a season of hope and new life. This year's focus is on communities who have been directly affected by allegations or convictions related to abuse – especially, but not exclusively, within the Church.
