


#### **TOTNES CHURCH CAR PARK**

It has been noticed that our car park is increasingly being used for unauthorised parking. This is expected to become a greater problem when the Churchill development is fully occupied. Accordingly, the current parking permits are going to be replaced with new ones that will show the car registration and will be valid for the next two years. Application forms for the new permits are at the back of the church or can be obtained by contacting Caroline, our parish secretary. The permits will only be issued to bona fide registered parishioners who make a financial contribution to the parish (e.g., Planned Giving, Gift Aid etc). To cover administration expenses the permits will cost £10 for each permit issued. The car park should only be used by parishioners attending church services or for short parking while shopping etc in town. Overnight parking is not permitted.

I am very sad to have to tell you that Mgr George Hay died earlier today (Monday 1st April). You may know that George's health had been declining for some time, and he had been feeling really tired of late. I'm told that he received Holy Communion earlier today when Deacon Tim Van Kroonenburg visited, and he died quite suddenly not long after.

George served faithfully as a priest in so many different ways during his 65 years of ministry, both in the Diocese and also at one time as Rector of the English College in Rome. To priests of my generation he was a father-figure and a really positive example of priestly life. He loved the Lord, loved serving the people, and he had a deep affection for clergy. He will be greatly missed.

Please keep George, his family (especially Chantal Thompson and Peter Thompson, his nephew and niece, who were very close to him), and all those who mourn him in your prayers.

Eternal rest grant unto him O Lord and let perpetual light shine upon him. May he rest in peace. May his soul, and the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace. Amen.

I will let you know about the details of George's funeral when they have been arranged.
