SEA SUNDAY 14TH JULY

This year Sea Sunday falls on July 14th, the one day in the year when nationally we pray for all fishermen and seafarers wherever they are, and thank God for the work that they do for the benefit of us all. In the Gospel for Sea Sunday Jesus sends out the disciples in pairs, taking almost nothing with them but relying on the generosity of the strangers they would meet on their journey. This requires faith! The teaching that God's love is present in welcoming strangers is a strong belief in many cultures. When we welcome others we welcome God. We may not meet seafarers and fishermen in person but we can pray for them and their families and by donating money we can help to provide for them whilst in port (being taken to Mass, taken to shops, internet access etc) and for their personal needs whilst at sea. 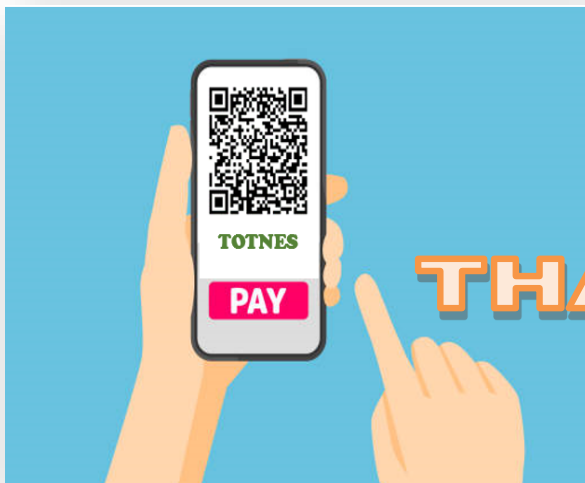
