NEW WORLD DAY OF THE POOR SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2025

The theme is "You are my hope" (based on Psalm 71:5). Pope Leo XIV has issued a message encouraging people to recognize the poor as subjects of hope rather than just recipients of charity. His message stresses that hope is found in God's faithfulness and that the poor are not a distraction, but a vital part of the Church that puts us in contact with the truth of the Gospel. Pope Leo urges us to see the poor and disenfranchised as creative subjects who can challenge us to live the Gospel in new ways.
