He founded the renowned multi faith peace schools (Mar Elias Educational Institutions) in Ibillin, Galilee. As well as receiving the Niwano Peace Prize, the World Methodist Peace Award plus several others, he has been nominated 3 times for the Nobel Peace Prize. All these reflect different aspects of his almost unique peace work.
